## **Playoff Notice**



## Division playoffs as described below based off end of session <u>standings. Playoffs are the first week after end of session</u>

- 4 Team Divisions: 1<sup>st</sup> vs. Wildcard. Winning team advances to 8 Ball Tri-Cup Qualifiers (9 ball winning team advances to 9 ball Fairfield Cup regionals)
- 5 or more Team Divisions: 1<sup>st</sup> vs. Wildcard, 2<sup>nd</sup> vs 3<sup>rd</sup> place. Two Winning teams advance to 8 Ball Tri-Cup Qualifiers. (9 ball winning teams play a 2<sup>nd</sup> round locally & winning team will advance to 9 ball Fairfield Cup regionals)
- ▶ 9 BALL DIVISIONS: 1<sup>st</sup> place team after playoffs will receive trophies &1<sup>st</sup> place plaque, runner up will receive 2<sup>nd</sup> place plaque, 1<sup>st</sup> place team advance to 9 Ball Fairfield Cup regionals.
- 8 BALL DIVISIONS: 1<sup>st</sup> place team after playoffs (played at Tri Cup tournament) will receive trophies & 1<sup>st</sup> place plaque, runner up will receive 2<sup>nd</sup> place plaque.

## Teams will advance to post-playoffs as described below

8 Ball Tri-Cup Qualifiers\*: scheduled after the first round of playoffs for winners, typically 4-6 weeks following the end of each session (exception Spring session may be sooner because of other qualifying events being scheduled).

\*Prize money and trophies awarded in Tri-Cup Qualifiers to final round teams.

\*\*Note: Teams may choose to play your 2nd round of playoffs at home instead of at 1st round of Tri-

Cup. This is OPTIONAL. If the match is played at home <u>each team must pay the \$50 weekly dues</u>. Both teams MUST agree to play the match at home and MUST notify the League Office to receive a scoresheet. Each team is responsible for their own scoresheet and dues. Each team will attend the following rounds at Tri-Cup because it is modified single elimination and must find out start time for their next scheduled Tri-Cup match.

8 Ball Best of the Rest (BOTR) Tournament: Second place teams in final round of Tri-Cup Qualifiers will be invited to BOTR. Annual tournament after Spring session, scheduled in late May or early June, to earn a spot in Fairfield Cup regionals.

\*Prize money not awarded in BOTR. Tournament only for trophies & to earn a spot in Fairfield Cup

BIG DAWG Team: one (1) team in the entire Fairfield County CT APA each session per format (three teams per year in 8 ball & 9 ball) that finishes highest in points from divisions of at least 6 teams and the Team must have at least 5 established players prior to the qualifying session to receive an award & invitation to an annual Battle of The Big Dawgs Tournament where prize funds will be awarded to each team based on team performance.

\*BIG DAWG Team must maintain Qualification requirements & achieve Top 50% division standings each following session. All players must stay active on a team in all subsequent sessions (Fall, Spring, Summer) & must meet minimum match requirements by end of Spring session (6 matches played on team and 10 lifetime).
